Policy requirements

Gardner Denver has implemented the following procedures & policies in accordance with 49 CFR 380-396 to ensure compliance with United States Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration rules and regulations regarding the use of CMV in the US & Canada.

- Certified copy of 3 year driving record
- Copy of the Medical Examiner's Certificate
- Copy of any Medical Waivers/Exemptions (If Applicable)
- Signed copy of the Gardner Denver Entry Level Driver Training Policy
- Signed copy of the Gardner Denver Driver Road Test
- Signed copy of the Gardner Denver Hours of Service Policy
- Signed copy of the Gardner Denver Maintenance Policy
- Maintenance Record File for each Commercial Motor Vehicle
- Signed copy of the Motor Vehicle Accident Policy
- Driver qualification file content
- Signed copy of the Gardner Denver Emergency Equipment Policy
- Gardner Denver Accident Record File for each Commercial Motor Vehicle
- Gardner Denver New & Intermittent Driver Form

Driver qualification file content

Gardner Denver Driver Qualification Files

Every motor carrier must maintain a driver qualification file for each driver it employs.

The file must include:

- Driver's Application for Employment (Page #4 & #5)
- Inquiry to previous Employers (Page #4)
- Driving Record for last 3 years (Page #7)
- Medical Examiner's Certificate (Page #9)
- If Granted, a Waiver/Exemption (Page #12)
- Driver Road Test and Certificate (Page #21 & #22)
- Annual Inquiry and Review of Driving Record (Page #35)
- Annual Driver Certification of Violations with Review (Page #36)
