WHAT IS AN INDUSTRY PARTNER MEMBERSHIP?

Any person, partnership, association, corporation, or distinct and separate operating unit thereof (having separate offices, management, plants, or stores, and personnel), whose business during the applicant's preceding accounting year was more than fifty percent (50%) by dollar sales volume that of upstream or midstream activities in the oil and gas sector shall be eligible for membership in the Association as an Industry Partner. A candidate company must also have the endorsement of two Energy Workforce Directors.

BECOMING A MEMBER

Joining Energy Workforce as an Industry Partner can be done in two easy steps:

1. Confirm your company is eligible for membership:
To be eligible for Industry Partner Membership status, a company or individual must qualify as stated above. This membership is \$15,000 annually.
